cams. All of which develops a very responsive 90kW @ 6,500rpm. Transmission is a choice of a crisp, short throw 5-speed manual or a silky smooth, 4-speed automatic with lock-up torque converter.

Then there's power assisted rack and pinion steering. Anti-roll bars front and rear. Four-wheel power assisted disc brakes. A drag co-efficient of only 0.34. All running on high performance 195/60-14 low profile Michelin tyres.

Don't be misled by the sleek appearance. The Honda Integra will carry four adults in comfort. And while ignoring the gimmicks and add-ons of over-competitive manufacturers, Honda have built in the sensible features that the enthusiast driver needs.

There's an analog instrument layout designed for the business end of motoring. There's a Pioneer sound system - AM/FM stereo cassette. And luxury trim levels. The total package is a sports car developed for people who know how to drive.

How safe is a car manufactured by a company that races Formula One?

How safe is a car designed by a company that performs structural crash tests on hundreds of vehicles every year? How safe is a car that rides on advanced suspension, brakes and handling geometry components? It's Honda safe. Because when Honda build a classic, they want it to be around for a long, long time.
